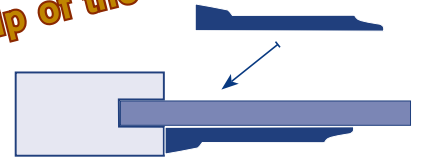

Shaker Profile

- A "Shaker" door has flat panels and square edges, no matter how many panels there are.
- Derived from Art Deco which originated in the 1920's & 30's, the streamlined look has again returned as all fashion is cyclical.
- Increase the panel thickness to improve noise-reduction and stability, but the thicker the panel the smaller the reveal.
- Shaker doors are not made for exterior use, the shaker edges will catch the rain/sleet/snow causing the elements to penetrate the seams which will lead to joint separation.
- Compliment your shaker doors with glass versions of the same style; any of our doors can be made with glass and it can be clear, frosted or bevelled.

Tip of the Month



Our "510SAM" adds a unique touch to the shaker profile, an applied moulding that gives a subtle character to the door panels. You can also have your wood worker apply your own desired moulding to our shaker doors.

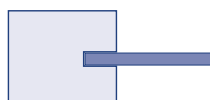
